Gueridon cart at **Gallagher's Steakhouse**

The recent revamp of classic steakhouse Gallagher's in Midtown picked up right where the vintage spot left off, only this time, the old-school service it boasted is back in style. Waiters in black dinner jackets revive the grandeur and charm of classic *gueridon* (tabletop cart) service with many of the dishes, from the filet mignon with blue cheese crust to Dover sole meunière to porterhouse for two and accompanying sides.
